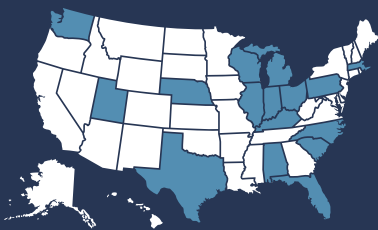

PROGRAM SPOTLIGHTS

IU Health Bloomington's brand new campus in **Bloomington, Indiana** opened in 2021 and was designed with trees in mind. Trees were intentionally incorporated into a healing garden, and the motif of trees and nature continues in the facility's indoor spaces through a place-based artwork installation called "Shades of Southern Indiana."

Caregivers and volunteers from **Cleveland Clinic Akron General** in **Akron, Ohio** planted 50 trees in a local park along with the facility's president, city council representatives, pastors from two neighborhood churches, a local librarian, NAACP leadership, and students from the nearby elementary school. The event highlights the essential need for genuine collaboration with local stakeholders when addressing tree equity.
